

## What is BBS?

**Bardet-Biedl Syndrome is a rare, recessively inherited disorder** which affects approximately 1 in 100,000 babies born.

### The main symptoms of this complex condition are:

- Visual impairment, often leading to blindness
- Extra fingers and/or toes
- Obesity
- Developmental delay
- Speech and co-ordination difficulties
- Learning difficulties
- Kidney abnormalities
- Other health problems may occur

Not all of the features are always present in those diagnosed as having BBS, and each one can vary in severity and appearance.




